# 2. SCHOOL UPDATE

# a) Principal report

- Let the planning begin!: The school is beginning planning for next year. Families of senior kindergarten students have been asked to select which program English or Early French Immersion.
- Update on class move and the new kindergarten class: The school is growing and has established a fourth kindergarten class with new teachers Ms. Dawn Decarie (English Kinder) and Ms. Meaghan Iwanowski (French Kinder), and Ms. Brooke (RECE). The class is comprised of students from the other three kindergarten classes, and the transition is going smoothly. The class is located in the Kinder wing of the school. M. Paul's class has moved into a new space.
- **PD Day (February 15):** Focus is on The Fundamentals of Math. There will be sessions specific to kindergarten students, grades 2-5 and for non-math teachers.
- **Report Cards**: Will be sent home Feb. 14. (See the <u>School Council January newsletter</u> for more about the grading system.)
- **Student Transfer Period:** Families can request a transfer to have their child attend a school other than their designated school from Feb. 4-19, 2019. More information is available on the OCDSB website.
- **Outdoor Equipment:** School is seeking \$300-400 to purchase items such as thermometers and compasses to use outdoors.

# b) Teacher update

- WE Day: WE Day events challenge our students to make a difference in the world by engaging in charitable activities that benefit the local and global community. This year, 54 Grade 5 students filled out detailed applications explaining why they should go to the WE Day event, and 14 were selected by draw. Those 14 students will meet at school at 5:45am on Monday, Feb. 11 and travel to Montreal by bus to participate in the WE Day event at Théatre Saint-Denis. The event runs from 9:00am-2:30pm, and the students are expected to be back at the school by 6:00pm. In the weeks to come, the 14 students will be sharing their insights with other classes in the school to spark ideas regarding how they can all help out in the community.
- **Choir:** The Grade 3, 4, 5 choir has been practising once a week to sing the national anthem acapella at the Ottawa 67s game on Friday, Feb. 15. Approximately 50 students will be taking part, and they will be wearing either hockey shirts or Robert Hopkins gear. Choir members' tickets are available for pick up at the office.
- Walk Safe: On Monday, Feb. 18, and Tuesday, Feb. 19, all of our Kindergarten through Grade 4 students will receive a pedestrian safety presentation given by the Ottawa Safety Council. As part of the presentation:
  - kindergarten students will practise crossing a model crosswalk while listening out for certain traffic sounds;
  - grade 1 and 2 students will be acting out both safe and unsafe behaviours using a model crosswalk; and

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grade 3 and 4 students will learn how distraction affects concentration by trying to complete complex tasks both with and without distraction.

- Carnaval: On Wednesday, Feb. 20, all Robert Hopkins students will participate in a full day of
  activities inspired by the Quebec Winter Festival, commonly known as Carnaval. Students will
  perform traditional French-Canadian songs and dances, they will create Carnaval-inspired visual
  art, and they will have a performance by a local French Canadian artist.
  - From 10:45am-12:45pm, students will also take part in a wide variety of outdoor winter activities such as snowshoeing, sled pulling, tobogganing, and cooperative ski-walking. The School is **seeking at least a dozen volunteers** from the school community to assist with these outdoor activities (at present we have only three). If you are available to help, **please contact M. Paul at paul.seif@ocdsb.ca**.
  - As part of the festivities, students will also have opportunities to warm up with nut-free hot
    chocolate, and they will get to sample maple syrup with apple slices. More information
    regarding these food items will be sent out next week.
- Arts: On March 18-19, the junior classes will take part in a Brazilian percussion workshop given by artist Luciano Porto. (Last year, our primary classes received a workshop from a group called the Junkyard Symphony.)
