- 5) Budget Update (Margaret)
  - Don't have it yet
  - \$2,796 (plus fundraising)
  - Maria: Requests from school?
    - o Nathalie: School purchased bins and outdoor equipment for grades 1-
      - 5 have to sort by cohorts, clean, etc. **Kinder could use same.** 
        - Nic: ~\$200 for bins for 14 classes
        - O Nathalie: Approx. \$3-400 for kinder. Depends on vendor.
        - Jamie: Could do with Scholastic credits.
          - Leslie to check

- Nathalie: some councils offer educator reimbursements (\$50-100 each) when we can fundraise
  - o Leslie: We've offered to buy teacher supplies from bookfair
  - o Donna: We can also do teacher wish lists for bookfair
  - Nathalie: Looking into more equity/inclusive books, but not ready to make requests
    - Jamie has done this exercise previously
  - Andy: Good to work towards a fundraising goal
  - Maria: Homework for the library tech to assess needs
  - Danielle: When we get Scholastic credits, get more value to order from them, but have also taken cash and given it to the teachers – usually we reinvest in the library. Leslie to figure out balance sooner than later (credits vs. cash).
  - o Jamie: Start with classroom libraries? Cohort libraries?
  - O Nic: Digital resources, e.g., Raz-kids

## 6) Discussion

- Suraya: Question re: class reorganization and numbers.
  - Nathalie: Grade ½ to have 15-16 students; Grade 2 to have 13 students; Grade 3 will have 17-18; Grade 4 17-18; other larger classes go down to 23-24 (Grade 1 numbers smaller than projected)
- Mary: Plan to put down gravel so kids are not walking through wet grass?
  - Nathalie: Portables have a paved area right up to the portable.
     Walkway created for portables.
  - Mary: Rearrange walking route so portable kids don't go around the whole field?
  - Nathalie: They have to go out at recess anyway. Will be sending out a
    message re: indoor shoes. Bring extra socks. COVID protocols designed
    for student safety, so have to leave it as it is.
- Ale: Will there be a 4<sup>th</sup> kinder class?
  - Nathalie: Advocated with planner, but not enough numbers to get another class. Ministry (COVID) funding less this year.
- Janet: Remind parents not to do U-turns in front of school.
  - Nathalie noting for Community Update.
- Leslie: Pick up/drop off traffic flow request to make consistent for planning
  - Nathalie: Entrance closed by 8 a.m. because driveway is used as learning and recess space – hard to pick a time, because have to wait until buses are done. Can tell people will close it at 7:55 a.m. in Community Update.
  - Suraya: Early start school; closing 5 mins early is difficult if you live farther from the school.
- Alanna/Tara: Busyness at pickups
  - o Nic: It is organized by grade as best as it can be
  - o Tara: Reminder to parents?
  - o Jamie: Walking school bus?
  - O Suraya: No U-turn sign? Request only one parent for pickup?
- Annalee: School population? [\_\_\_\_\_]
