- 2) School Update (Nathalie)
 - Valentine's Day first time exchanging valentines since COVID-19 started
 - Black Excellence Month
 - Kiss and Ride problems may have to close if concerns continue
 - Suraya: Parking lot inaccessible, but neighbours don't want people to park there either. Inaccessible for people who live far away. Keep those people – the majority – in mind when making rules.
 - Discussion ensues regarding lack of diversity and representation on School Council.
 - Jamie: As a School Council, there are limited things we can address. Hiring isn't one of them.
 - Jamie and Suraya to take discussion re: hiring and representation offline.
 - Jamie: In terms of the Kiss and Ride, the issue is safety. Two things to think about: 1. Facilitating getting kids to school. 2.



Safety. Closing of Kiss and Ride is not to make it more difficult. To make it safe. My solution, and others are doing it too, is to park in the church and walk from there.

- Nathalie: My hope is Kiss and Ride will remain open.
- Maria: Desperately looking for solutions that work for everyone. A couple people could ruin this program for everyone. No parent volunteers (because not allowed on property) and no kids are allowed to escort younger kids (because of cohorting/COVID). Board is very risk averse.
- Danielle: How widely is the community update read? It may be that those people who need it the most (e.g., occasional users of kiss and ride) may not be reading those messages.
 Maybe make an exception and send home paper notes. Re: the church, kids can walk together from there. There is a crossing guard.
- Andy: Glenhurst Cres. is happy to have people park there. It doesn't block traffic and is very close to the school.
- Donna: Concerned that if Kiss and Ride is taken away, parking lot will be worse.
- Kallyan: M-43 bus is not running. Here to find a solution.
- Maria: My concern is that teachers can't do everything. Hopeful that parents could volunteer.
- Nathalie: Not sure what Board would allow. Hopeful for vaxxed, masked volunteers. Think we're headed in that direction. Teachers can only supervise a mandated number of minutes each week. Could hold signs.
- Kallyan: Suggestion of parent or volunteer directing kids; quicker flow
- Nathalie: Hopeful to have teachers be able to get children out of vehicles faster with relaxed protocols. Please spread the word that Kiss and Ride needs to be safe.
