### Admin Update (Mme Sharma & M. Paul)

- o Thanks for everyone who helped out with the School Welcome BBQ
- o Mural Update (ask) the sizes of the ones on the website turned out to be half the size needed (for \$2-3000). To fill the whole wall that needs the wall mural, we need approximately \$5000. Mural will include languages spoken, motto, mascot, name, indigenous symbols, and things that the community sees that represents our school. May be in installments. Won't be done until next summer. Deposit of \$500 once 'approved'.
